We're delighted to welcome you and your child to Nettlesworth Primary School as part of our new reception class!

I'm Mrs Donna Lee and I'm headteacher at Nettlesworth Primary School, Mrs Morton (previously known as Miss Grant) will be your child's reception teacher and Mrs Plant will be covering Mrs Morton's maternity leave for the Autumn Term as she is due her baby boy in August.
