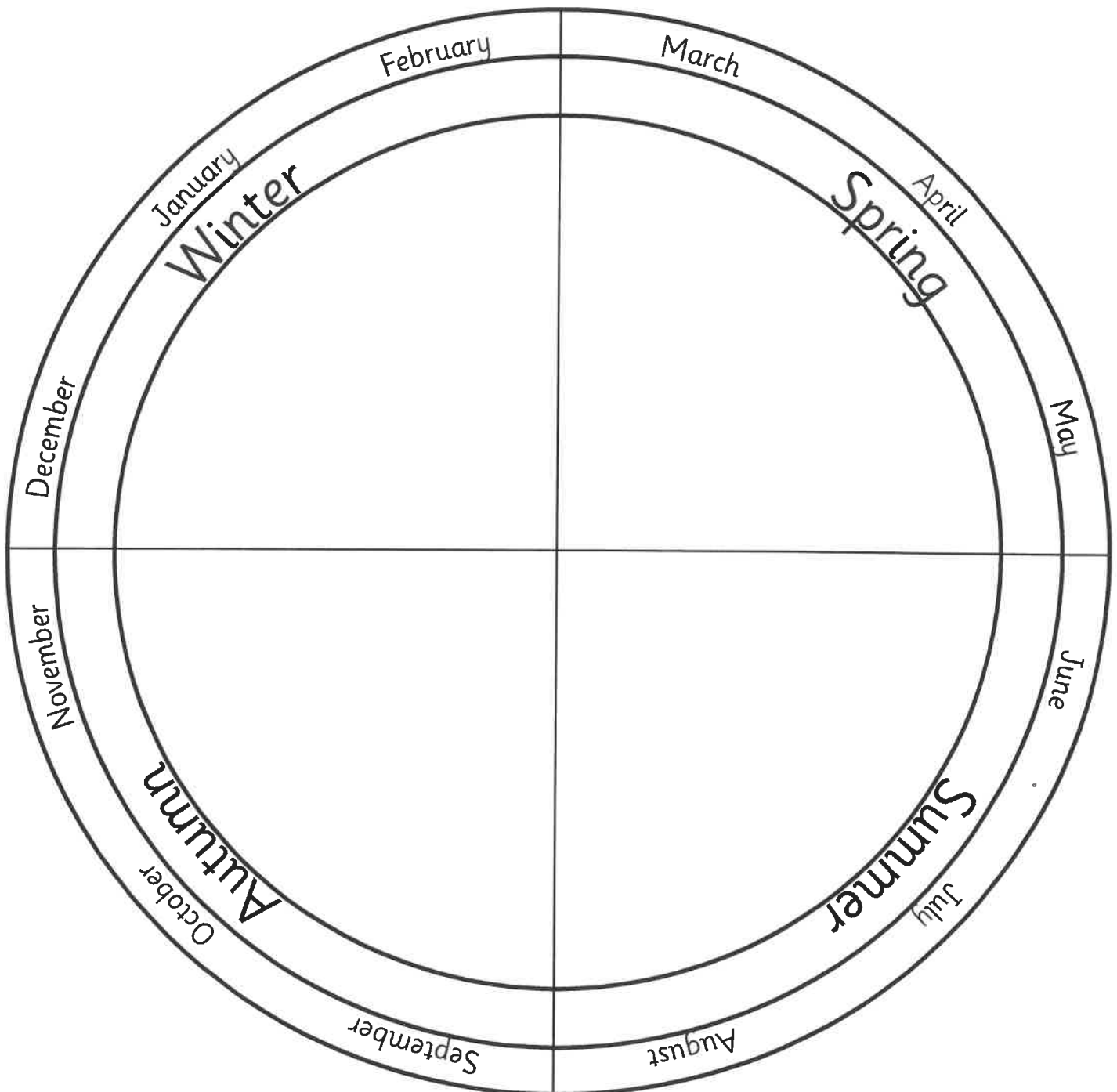


Seasons Wheel
