	Children in Need	November	Raising money for charity. Pudsey baking and spotty enhancements.
	Christmas Jumper Day	December	Children wear festive jumpers.

	Pancake Day (Shrove Tuesday)	February	Pancake making and tossing, maths links, recipes. (In half term)
	Valentine's Day	February	Celebration of someone you love – crafts and cards invitation to create. (In half term)
Spring 2	World Book Day	March	Dressing up as their favourite book characters and engage in activities to encourage reading, guest and secret story tellers.

	Ramadan	Starts March	Muslim celebration - Invite families partaking in Ramadan to share their own stories and traditions.
