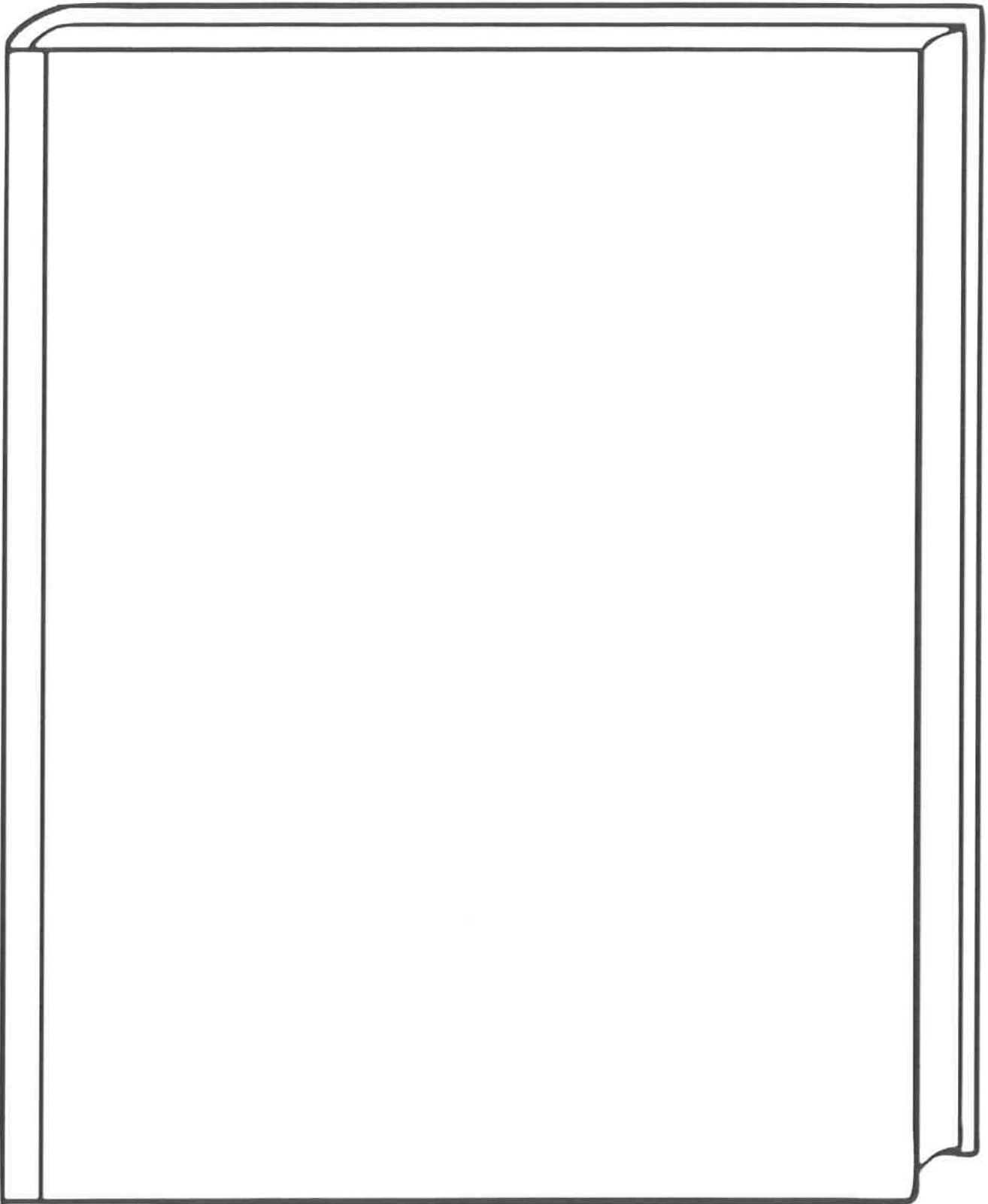


Book Cover Design

Design a new cover for your favourite book.

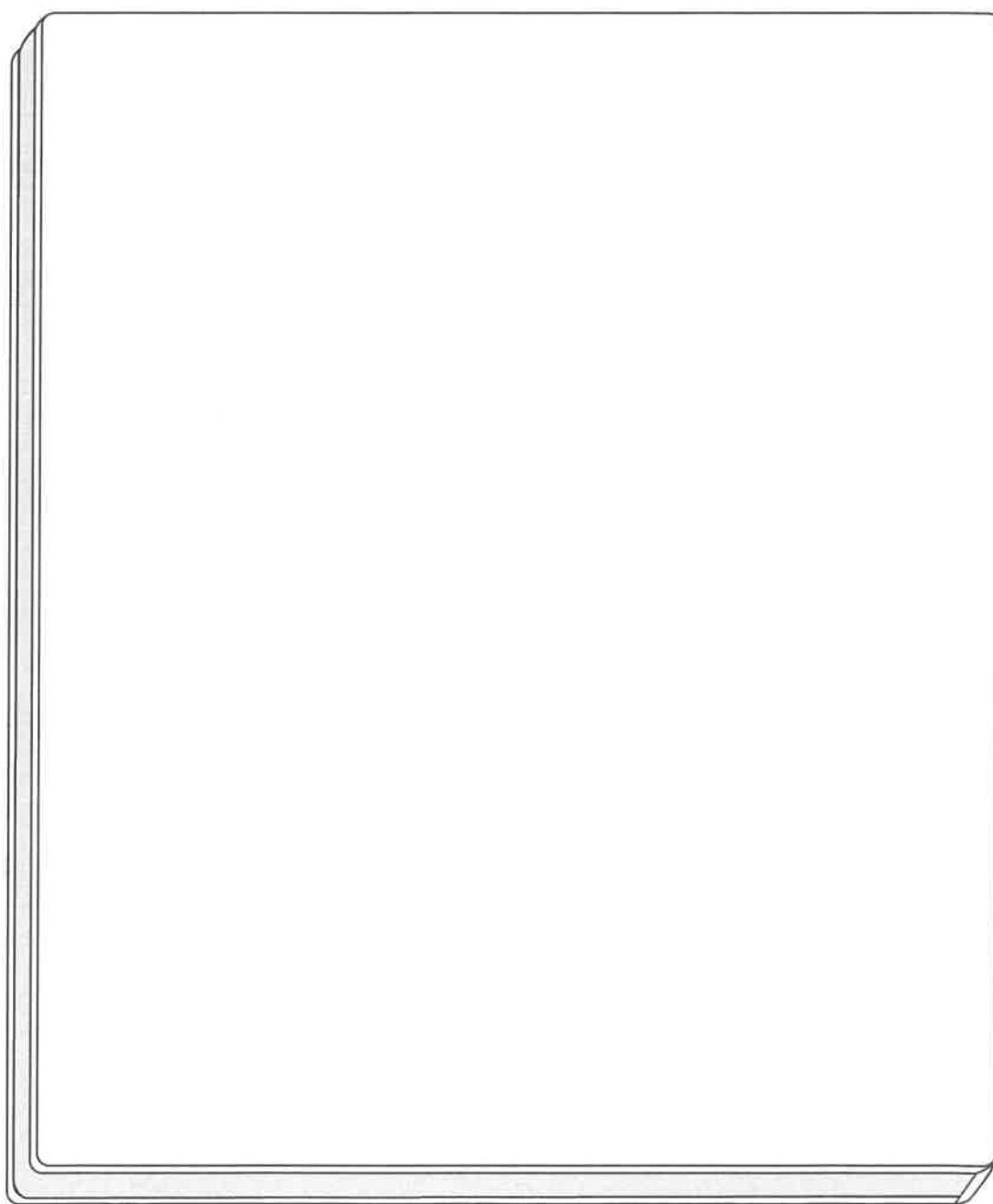


Blurb
