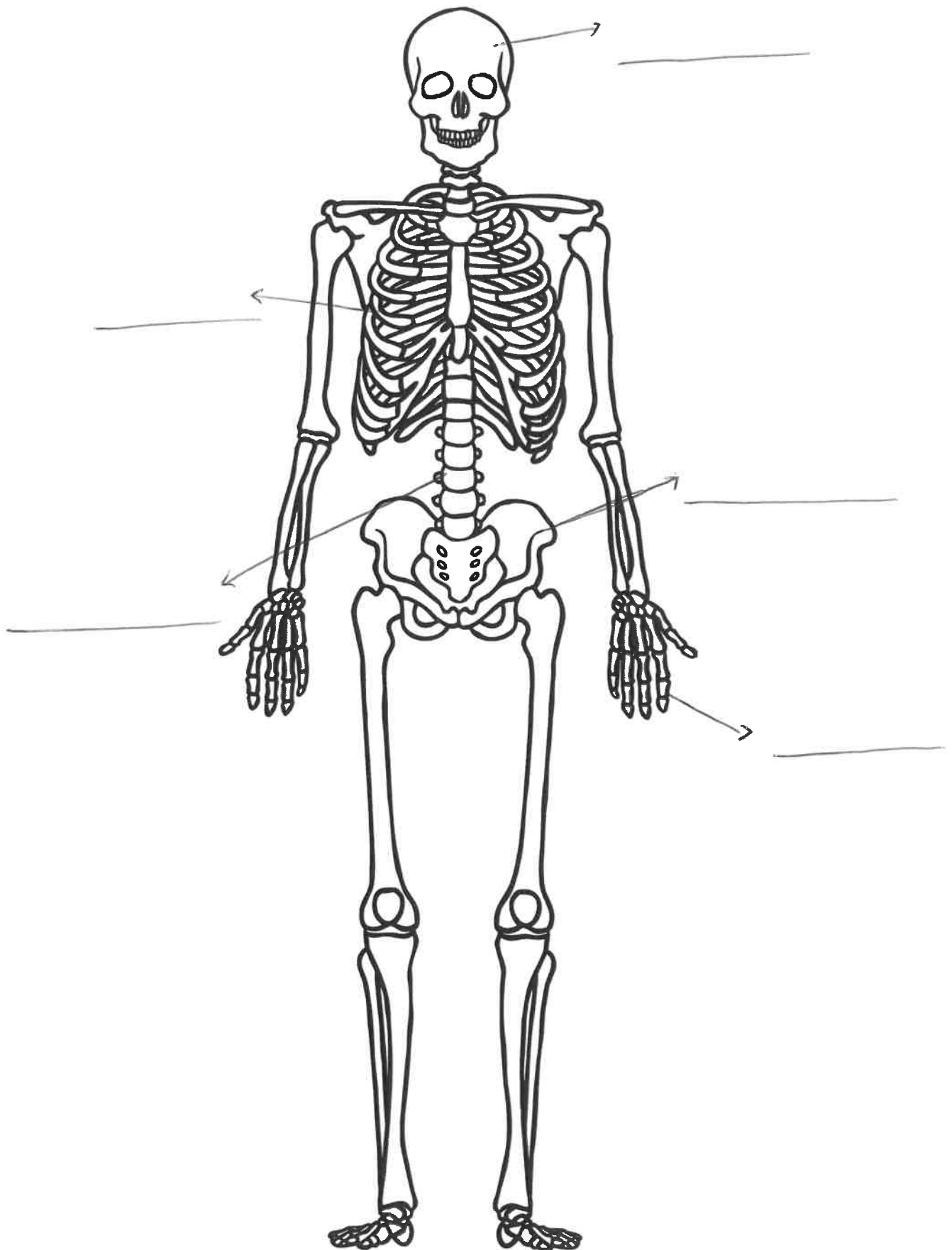

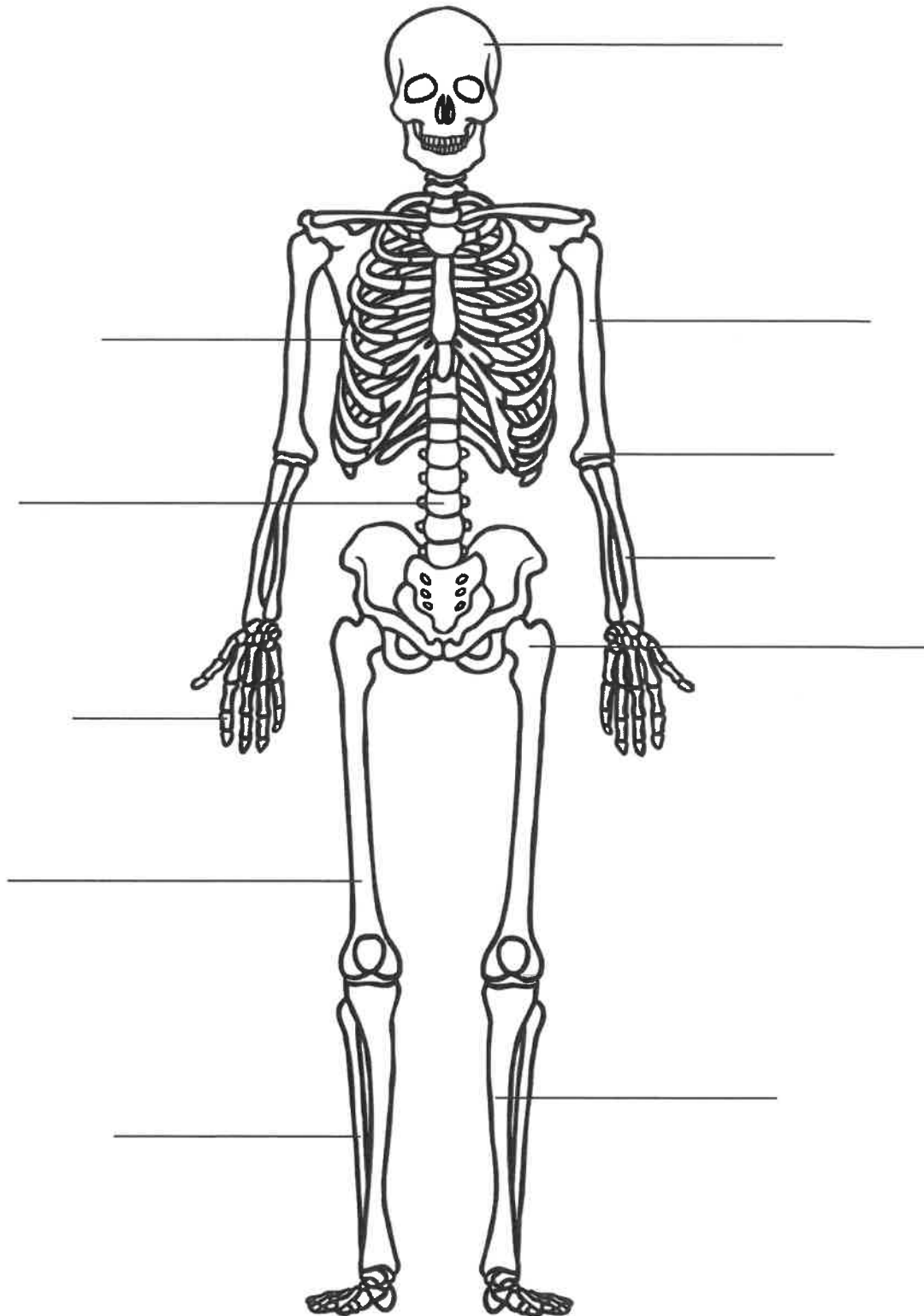

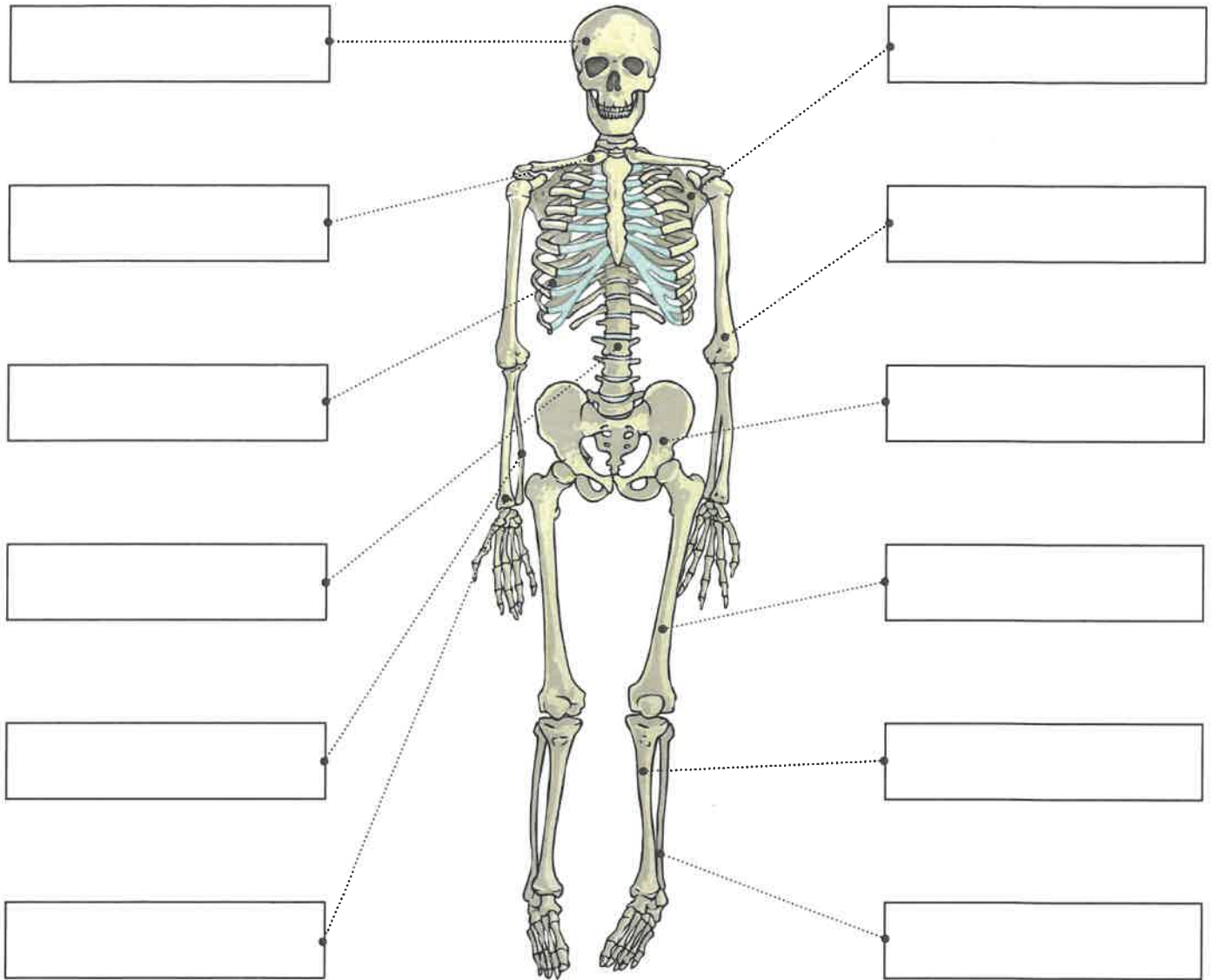
Name the bones in the body using the words at the bottom of the page.
